Sub: Exemption from mandatory weighment in case of low density Commodities – Reg.

Railway Board vide their letter 6th cited (copy enclosed) mentioned that the subject issue was reviewed by them and it has been decided to extend dispensation of mandatory (100%) weighment of wagon/rake loaded with Petroleum Coke and/or Metallurgical Coke with a provision that atleast 5% of rakes should be subjected to weighment. While permitting the above exemption they stated that it may be ensured that no commodity in any form other than these commodities is loaded in the wagon/rake.

These instructions will be effective for the period beyond 26-05-2019, till further advise.

However, guidelines to permit weighment of Petroleum Coke and/or Metallurgical Coke on the request of Consigner as prescribed vide Railway Board letter 3rd cited will continue to apply unchanged. These instructions from Railway Board was also circulated to all concerned vide this office Circular 5th cited.

All concerned to note and act accordingly.

(iii) Board's letter No.TC-I/2017/109/3 dt.13.06.2018

In terms of Addendum under reference (ii), dispensation from mandatory(100%) weighment of wagon/rake loaded with Petroleum Coke and/or Metallurgical Coke has been permitted with a proviso that atleast 5% of rakes should be subjected to weighment. These guidelines are valid upto 26.05.2019.

The matter has been reviewed and it has been decided to extend the currency of above-mentioned guidelines beyond 26.05.2019 **till further advice.**

However, guidelines to permit weighment of Petroleum Coke and/or Metallurgical Coke on the request of consignor as prescribed vide Board's letter No.TC-I/2017/109/3 dt.13.06.2018 will continue to apply unchanged.

This issues in consultation with Traffic Transportation Dte. and with the concurrence of Finance Dte. of Ministry of Railways.
