With reference to the above subject cited, the trade is hereby informed to take necessary precautions to prevent overloaded heavy vehicles plying on the port road and to ensure that they are leak proof as the excess material falling from vehicles is causing hazards to the road users.

Please take note that, the cargo carrying vehicles are leak proof and any excess cargo falling from vehicles on to port road is a matter of serious concern of road safety while causing inconvenience for movement of heavy cargo vehicles.
